Major Life Activity	Describe Substantial Limitation

Substantially limits means: "The individual's major life activity is restricted as to the conditions, manner, or duration under which they can be performed in comparison to most people. An impairment need not prevent or severely or significantly restrict a major life activity to be considered substantially limiting." Substantially limits would include when a student: a) is **unable** to perform a major life activity that the average student of approximately the same age can perform, or b) is **restricted** as to the condition, manner or duration under which a particular life activity is performed as compared to the average student of approximately the same age. The impairment must be **substantial and somewhat unique**, rather than commonplace, when compared to the average student of approximately the same age.

- Student has a record of having such an impairment (i.e., previously had, but no longer has an impairment).
 Student is regarded as having such an impairment (i.e., has never had an impairment, but is treated by others as such).
